STENEHJEM TO REVIEW METH LAWS AT RETAILER'S CONVENTION

BISMARCK – Attorney General Wayne Stenehjem will make a presentation at the North Dakota Retail Association annual trade convention, to explain recent changes in federal laws restricting sales of certain cold and allergy medicines and how those changes affect retailers. State laws enacted in 2005 resulted in a dramatic reduction in the number of meth lab busts, and the federal laws are expected to further the state's efforts. Stenehjem will provide information to assist retailers in complying with both state and federal laws.

The convention is today, October 25, 2006, at the Ramada Plaza Suites Hotel in Fargo. Stenehjem's session begins at 4:00 pm.
